wrap around booth (only on 25G). The 22B and 23R do not include any of the above options. In addition to items noted above, the Tioga also include exterior entertainment center, A/C 15BTU with heat pump, sani-flush, dash upgrade, and power heated rear view mirrors. Tioga SL models 31L, 31W include exterior entertainment. Sani-flush on all SL models.

## Value Explanations

Prices shown are retail consumer values and to be considered as selling prices. Trade-in values are to be determined by local dealers and are generally lower than values shown.
